## Admission Criteria

The Laurel Hall School special education program located in Frederick County is available for admission to any male or female student ranging in age from 5 through 21, in Kindergarten through grade 12, and nongraded students ages 5 to 21, who have been determined to have an emotional disability, autism, or is multiply disabled and is in need of a high level of structure with extensive and intensive academic and behavioral support services.

Accommodations and interventions for each student's academic performance, individual learning styles, and behavioral needs are provided at each student's academic level. Students will be considered for admission that are functioning academically on, below, or above grade level.

Students are appropriate for admission who demonstrate behaviors that include but are not limited to aggression, anxiety, attention deficit, hyperactivity, withdrawal, compulsions, repetitive and stereotypic actions, and inadequate social skills. There are no specific behavioral characteristics that would preclude admission but each admission is reviewed on a case by case basis by the Program Director or Education Director. Laurel Hall reserves the right to decline any admission deemed not appropriate for the program or based on the lack of available classroom space.

On an annual basis, in July, or more frequently if needed, Laurel Hall School in Frederick will distribute the above written statement of criteria for admission to each school system.

Referrals for admission are made from the local school system to the Program or Education Director of Laurel Hall School in Frederick, 4540B Mack Avenue, Frederick, MD 21703.
